PEN ONLY TO HORSES TALLIONS THAT BREEDERS INCENTIVE PROGRAM, the 5-State Breeders Futurity is unlike any other futurity in the nation. In its 18th year of production, the 5-State Breeders Futurity produced by LI Productions once again outdid itself bringing a record payout, and along with it, record high entry numbers for the Rapid City, South

With 76 futurity entries, 58 maturity entries, plus open 5D numbers combining for a grand total of 634 entries over the three-day event, the 5-States paid out \$69,300 sharing the wealth among a \$20,000-added futurity with a \$2,000added 2D side pot, a \$5,000-added matua \$2,000-added amateur, \$2,000-added open 5D and \$10,000-added Future

Lana Dacar of LI Productions celebrated her eighth year of producing the stellar event and said it was one of the toughest years of competition she's seen.

"What a set of horses and what a set of trainers!" Dacar said of the 2015 futurity. "I posted the draw about a week before the futurity and I said I thought this would be one of the most talented groups of horses to run down the alley of the James Kjerstad Event Center. I think that
